Because Life is Not A REHEARSAL!

Unlike many training facilities which have their students come to them, Crisis Resolution Training Consultants (CRTC) offers a mobile training unit. This fast-paced, realistic training program was developed by Bennie Cooley, Jr., a member of the Special Operations Division of the Department of Energy in Idaho. He has over 15 years experience in Counter Terrorism and SWAT training and has cross trained with various agencies including specialized military units, FBI and local law enforcement. In fact, Bennie was leader of the 1991 and 1992 Championship Team at the IPS/PMA National Championship of SWAT in Gainesville, Georgia.

One of the most unique aspects of CRTC's training is that, in addition to simply teaching fundamentals and tactical skills, this course begins with a discussion and presentation of a survival philosophy. Such ideas as how to condition the mind and thought processes to deal with a life-threatening situation and the manner in which the desire for personal comfort can create a deadly situation are discussed. Students are encouraged to think, not simply act in the same manner as always (or take up the passive or "I don't care" attitude). As Bennie explains, "The person who understands and recognizes how to control these illusive enemies stands a better chance of surviving a hos-

tile situation than a person who succumbs to the inherent natural desire for personal comfort and a 'can't win' passive outlook."

Among the courses that CRTC offers at your department's location are:

Advanced Tactical Shooting (recommended for firearms instructors) - 3 day course - (majority of time spent on range perfecting shooting skills, tactical survival rules, gun take away)

Self Defense Handgun Level II

- Officer Survival - 3 day course - (advanced self defense techniques to avoid confrontation or deal with the situation successfully, physical and mental conditioning in classroom and field environment, weapons retention, action vs. reaction, tactical clearing)

Self Defense Handgun Level III

- Officer Survival - 4 day course - (70% of this advanced course instructed in darkness, refine techniques learned in Level II and go beyond, multiple attackers in low-light situations, high stress situations forcing split second decisions)

Weapons Retention & Disarming

(recommended for field training officers and department trainers) - 2 day course - (learn to maintain control of firearm at all times, disarming techniques, deadly force guidelines, mental conditioning)

Urban Tactical Rifle I - (recommended for the patrol officer) - 3 day course - (basic to intermediate shooting fundamentals using assault rifle, classroom and field training, physical and mental conditioning, tactical movement, deadly force guidelines and equipment)

Urban Tactical Rifle II - (recommended for high-risk entry & SWAT officers) - 3 day course - (intermediate to advanced use of assault rifle for offensive

and defensive situations, close quarter engagements, action vs. reaction, tactical movement, gun take away)

Urban Tactical Rifle Instructor's Course - (recommended for departmental firearms instructors) - 4 day course - (designed to enhance skills with AR-15 style rifles, intermediate to advanced shooting techniques, Tac Team movement, urban movement, gun take-away techniques, human nature)

Tactical Team Training (SWAT)

- 4 day course - (class & field training, high-risk warrants, hostage rescue, open air vehicle repossession, individual & team skills, tactical planning, EET, clearing, communication, diversions, team movement)

Vehicle Assaults - 3 day course - (specialized training for conducting tactical assault on a vehicle, condition student mentally and physically for dealing with different types of vehicle clearing, learn to plan, rehearse and conduct techniques in daylight and nighttime environments)
